FOUNDING DOCUMENT

The charity was set up by means of a constitution that was accepted by the Office of the Scottish Regulator on 9 October 2017.

CHARITABLE PURPOSES

The charitable purposes of the Association are the advancement of education and the advancement of the arts, heritage, culture or science by providing a website, information, educational resources, talks and exhibitions about the Holocaust and the refugee experience to the general public, students and school children and by learning from testimonies of Holocaust survivors and refugees from Nazi persecution who have settled in Scotland.

ACTIVITIES

The Association had another busy and successful year in 2020. In January, Howard Singerman gave the keynote address at the East Renfrewshire/Renfrewshire Holocaust Memorial Event. Howard's speech was very well received by the large audience. Our mobile exhibition was again featured at this annual event.

Also in January, Steven and Hilary Anson spoke to 250 pupils at Govan High School and at that time the mobile exhibition was at Calderwood Lodge Primary School. During this period, in addition to Calderwood Lodge pupils, schoolchildren from St Clare's, St Vincent's, Carolside, Kirkhill and Hillview Primary Schools viewed the exhibition and heard talks from Howard Singerman and Steven and Hilary Anson. More than 650 pupils and teachers heard the talks and viewed the exhibition whilst it was at Calderwood Lodge.

The onset of Covid prevented us from taking our exhibition and giving talks to other schools. However, we expanded our online resources to enable us to communicate virtually with schools and other users. During the year, we created several podcasts and put them on our website. We also completely refurbished and greatly improved our website. As well as audio interviews with transcripts, the website now contains a large number of video interviews and substantial other educational resources about the Holocaust.

Angela Shapiro did the following presentations by Zoom: -

- 1. 'And then I came to Live in Glasgow' in November for Scottish Interfaith Week. About 30 households attend.
- 2. Presentation to 4th level History students online entitled 'Gathering the Voices'. 45 students attended in November.
- 3. Presentation to Limmud in December. Over 100 households joined the talk called 'And then I came to Glasgow'.

There have been no changes in the trustees during the year.

TRUSTEES REMUNERATION AND EXPENSES

The Trustees received reimbursement of expenses of £625 during the year (2019: £133).
